The G&Z Walk Box Allows Ground Level Track Control for Quick Width Changes

The G&Z *Walk Box* is a remote control that allows the equipment operator to control one set of tracks from the ground level. The *Walk Box* gives the operator the ability from the ground to “walk” the left or right tracks in or out to perform width changes. With the G&Z *Walk Box*, the operator has the capability to slowly and accurately move a side of the machine without ascending to the operator console.

The *Walk Box* can be connected to the Left or Right Track Pump Electric Displacement Control (E.D.C.)* on the G&Z S600, S850, S1500, PS1200, and TC1500 (TC850). When the *Walk Box* is in use, the speed and forward/reverse controls on the operator console will not work for the side being controlled. This innovative product has been designed to run on only a single AA battery.



*The *Walk Box* connects to the E.D.C. using a Straight Plug, Size 14 Shell, 4 pin connector. It attaches directly to the track pump replacing the existing cord.
